# The Core Challenge

- ▶ Municipalities and NGOs are forced to deploy scarce resources based on estimates and perception, not data.
- ▶ Until the American Strays Project, no organization had conducted a scientific baseline survey of free-roaming dogs in major US cities.
- ▶ This critical lack of standardized methodology prevents an accurate understanding of population dynamics.
- ▶ Without facts, finding efficient funding and resolving community animal crises is nearly impossible.



# Science Meets Cinema

## Quantitative Data

We systematically document the "free-roaming" population, permanently removing opinion from the equation and replacing it with undeniable fact. Our methodology ensures data is standardized, transparent, and fully auditable.

## Visual Storytelling

We combine rigorous metrics with top-tier investigative documentary storytelling. Our data does not sit in a folder; it is translated into compelling, broadcast-quality narratives that drive global awareness and legislative action.



# Next-Gen Survey Ecosystem



## Spatial Tracking

Utilizing open-source mapping data via OSMTracker and the Google Earth OpenStreetMap App to pinpoint exact locations with visual support.



## Absolute Audit

Deploying advanced hardware including GPS, drones, and 360-degree 5K video serving as an undeniable and published visual audit.



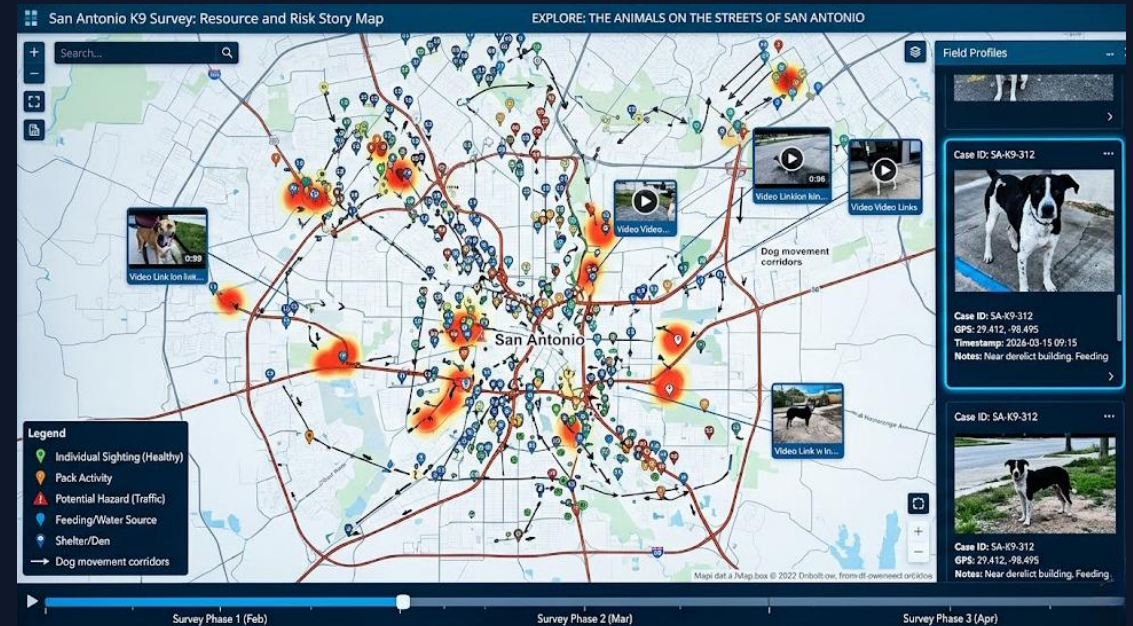
## Targeted Accuracy

Training specialized volunteer field teams to acquire highly accurate, customized municipal data safely, efficiently, and objectively.



# Transforming San Antonio

San Antonio presents a stubbornly difficult landscape where top-down animal welfare enforcement often fails. WA2S utilizes the **Asset-Based Community Development (ABCD)** method to flip the script. Instead of focusing on deficits, we mobilize existing community strengths. By empowering residents as citizen scientists, we build trust and foster sustainable, hyper-localized solutions that truly work.

## Canine Survey

Conducting quarterly street-by-street headcounts to establish crucial 3 year and 13 year longitudinal baseline counts .



## Knowledge

Empowering the public with peer-reviewed data and feature documentaries, like Unleashed: Dogs of San Antonio.



## Outreach

Amplifying raw data into accessible story maps, television programs, and the Pet Promise 26 episode by 60 second educational PSA series.

## History and Background of WA2S

### The Intersection of Science and Storytelling

The World Animal Awareness Society (WA2S.org) is an award-winning 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization dedicated to illuminating the complex relationships between humans and animals. Rather than simply telling audiences about animal welfare issues, WA2S places them directly on the front lines, utilizing a documentary approach to capture authentic, unfiltered narratives that drive actionable change.

### Leadership and Vision

Under the direction of Executive Director and professional cinematographer Tom McPhee, WA2S has redefined what nonprofit advocacy looks like in the digital age. By applying premium filmmaking standards to philanthropic missions, the organization ensures that its campaigns are not only factually grounded but visually compelling. This commitment to top-tier content creation has propelled the organization's digital presence into the top 1% of YouTube creators globally, proving that high-quality, authentic storytelling can mobilize massive audiences for the greater good.

### #WA2SFilms and Global Collaboration

The driving engine behind the organization's reach is its dedicated media wing, #WA2SFilms. Recognizing that no single entity can solve systemic animal welfare crises alone, #WA2SFilms has functioned as a massive collaborative hub. To date, the media wing has partnered with over 2,200 distinct organizations around the world. These collaborations empower local rescues, advocates, and scientists by providing them with the high-impact advocacy content necessary to elevate their localized efforts onto a global stage.

### Landmark Projects and Ongoing Impact

WA2S does not shy away from the most challenging realities of animal welfare. Through exhaustive, boots-on-the-ground documentary work, the organization tackles vast, systemic issues.
